Veneers can also be shaped to close gaps between teeth and, as an alternative to braces, correct the appearance of crowded or overlapped teeth.

Not only that, but natural teeth emit fluorescence under ultraviolet rays. Since natural enamel is translucent, it allows some of the inner light to shine through. Smiling With Dental Implants

Who wouldn't want to look better, speak better, eat better ... and smile more? Dental implants are now the treatment of choice for many people who need to replace missing teeth.

Implants are considered by many dentists to be a more conservative treatment than crowns or bridges. They require only normal brushing and flossing to maintain oral health, unlike bridges that may make cleaning awkward. Because implants are anchored into the jawbone like the roots of your teeth, they act like natural teeth and preserve and strengthen the underlying bone. There is no need to compromise adjacent healthy teeth, and there are no plates that affect comfort and fit.

An implant has two parts: a root made of biocompatible metal, and a custom-made tooth crown which is

attached to it. Most implants are made of titanium, an inert metal proven effective at fusing with living bone. Implants can be used to stabilize dentures and bridges, replace just one tooth or to rebuild an entire jaw of missing teeth. The best part is that they look and feel just like natural teeth. In one survey, patients who had their prosthetic appliances replaced with implants rated them nine out of ten - second only to natural teeth! And they're suitable for patients ranging from their teen years and up - there's no upper limit - and who practice good oral home care and maintain regular dental checkups.
